

2012 Orange Motorcycle (Tangerine Dream) Raffle Official Rules - Sponsored by Hogs & Heroes Foundation

PRIZES

The First Prize winner for the October 6th, 2012 drawing will be awarded a 2003 C & C Cycle Custom Swoopy Softail (Tangerine Dream) with an official retail value of \$63,500.

Winner does not need to be present at the drawing, but must present their entry stub when claiming the prize. A "donation" shall not occur and be binding on Hogs & Heroes Foundation until funds received for the same have cleared the bank. Raffle donations may be made in-person at any site designated as an official outlet or where Hogs & Heroes Foundation tickets are on display. Please Note: US Postal Regulation do NOT allow ticket stubs to be mailed via US Mail.

Each donation shall constitute an "entry" into the raffle drawing, and the person to whom the entry is registered shall be the "Entrant." Although more than one name may

be provided on the entry registration form, the entry shall be registered to the first name listed, who shall constitute the sole Entrant for that ticket.
